What is Suicide Care?

- Systems approach to comprehensive suicide prevention that includes:
 - Prevention;
 - Intervention;
 - I Treatment; and
 - Postvention.

• A continuous and trauma-sensitive approach to care.



Suicide Care Initiative

 A Mental Health Block Grant-funded project managed by HHSC suicide prevention team.

- TEXAS Health and Human Services
- The focus is to enhance suicide care in the public mental health system through local infrastructure in the LMHAs and LBHAs.
- SCI continues the implementation of safer suicide care practices.



Zero Suicide

- The foundational belief that suicide deaths for people in health and behavioral health care systems are preventable.
- A practical framework of research-based best practices for system-wide transformation toward safer suicide care.
